# Richland 0

The Kennewick High school football team easily defeated the Richland High team on Friday afternoon on the Kennewick field. The first minute indicated that the score might be low, but such was not the case.

Kennewick was lucky when the coin was tossed and chose to defend the north goal; having a slight wind at her back, Richland kicked to the Kennewick 30 yard line, where it was fumbled by a Kennewick line man and recovered by Adkins, the Richland fullback. Richland attempted to carry the ball farther into Kennewick territory, but after three downs only succeeded in carrying it five yards. Ross punted and it was Kennewick's ball on her own 20-yard line. After one minute of play the Kennewick left carried the ball 40 yards for a touchdown, and Johnson kicked goal.

Kennewick kicked to Adkins on his 10 yard line, who ran the ball 25 yards before being downed. Richland could not gain the necessary ten yards and was forced to punt. Then Kennewick began an attack that got her touchdowns, at the rate of one about every three minutes. Time was the only element that would determine how many she would get before the first half ended. She was playing straight football, doing wide end runs, with the halves and tackles carrying the ball. Score at end of first half, 38 to 0.

Richland braced a little in the third quarter and held Kennewick to two touchdowns. The line played better in this quarter and once Kennewick failed to make the necessary 10 yards and Richland had the ball on her own 30 yard line, but could not gain.

In the last half Kennewick got three touchdowns, one the result of a blocked punt and the others by straight football.

The game was clean and free from penalties, there being but two called, one on each side, for being off side.

Kennewick's team showed a knowledge of the game and her line played well on defense, but the team, as a whole, showed lack of condition.

The Richland team had had only two weeks' practice and only two men who had ever played interscholastic football. Due to a late start the team had not been properly conditioned, a fact evident before the game ended.
