

# Bombers Flatten Prosser

**PROSSER** — Riding Jack Morrow's wide shoulders and Bill Tracy's flashing legs, Richland's Bombers walked all over the local Mustangs here Friday night 27-0.

Big Morrow made three touchdowns for himself in the game — all by shouldering his way through clutching Prosser tacklers smack through the middle of the line.

Richland, in its season opener, looked good against an opponent weak through the middle but strong on the ends. Most of the Bombers' rushing gains were made by Morrow over the guards and tackles.

## STATISTICS LOPSIDED

The statistics were as one-sided as the score. Richland led in first downs 15-3, in net yards gained 296-64, and in yards rushing 277-35.

All the Richland team waited for in its first score was to get its hands on the ball. Prosser punted and the Bombers took over on the Mustang 32. Morrow and Tracy alternated in short, slashing gains until Morrow pushed the last yard through the middle of the line. Marcum kicked the point to make it 7-0 halfway through the first quarter. The quarter ended with that score.

Behind savage blocking, Morrow and Tracy together accounted for the second tally. Richland took over on the Prosser 35 this time. Morrow went off tackle from the six for the

score. Marcum again made the extra point with a high, true place kick. The half ended at 14-0.

## AERIAL PLAYS WORK

Richland's aerial warriors found themselves early in the second half. After not connecting at all in the first half Tracy nailed Jack Dawson for three quick passes in the third quarter. With another 13 yard smash by Morrow, Tracy scampered around end for eight yards. Then he set his feet and rifled the ball to Dawson on the goal line for another score. The try for point failed making it 20-0.

Taking a Prosser punt mid-field, the ball moved rapidly down the field in the hands of Tracy, Flake, Scott, and McKeown. Then in two short smashes, Morrow chalked up his third touchdown of the night. Marcum's kick for point was good just before the third quarter ended to make the final score 27-0.

The line of scrimmage saw-sawed back and forth in the fourth quarter, with many Richland reserves in the line-up, and no scoring was done.
